CHAPTER 130: OFFENSES AGAINST PROPERTY

§ 130.01 DAMAGING EQUIPMENT OF POLICE DEPARTMENT.

It shall be unlawful for any person to take, damage, destroy, or in any way to interfere with any equipment or property belonging to or used by the Police Department.

§ 130.02 INTERFERING WITH FIRE DEPARTMENT PROPERTY.

It shall be unlawful for any person to take, damage, interfere with or otherwise meddle with any equipment or property of the Fire Department.

§ 131.01 GETTING ON AND OFF TRAINS IN MOTION.

It shall be unlawful for any person to get on or off a railroad train while the train is in motion for the purpose of a free ride.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

§ 132.01 DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS.

It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any gun or other firearm, or any rocket, cannon cracker or any other fireworks or explosive in any street or footway, or in any place within the Black Mountain Town Limits, except in self defense or by command or permission of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen.

MOLOTOV COCKTAILS; FIREBOMBS

§ 132.10 DEFINITIONS.

For the purpose of this chapter, the following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

MOLOTOV COCKTAIL. Any breakable container or any container which is designed in a manner that upon being propelled it will at impact empty its contents, which is filled with an inflammable fluid or substance, and which is fitted with a fuse or wick.

FIREBOMB. Any type of object designed or constructed so that upon being propelled it will explode or ignite its area of impact.

§ 132.11 USE OR POSSESSION PROHIBITED.

It shall be unlawful for any person to manufacture, possess, transport or use any molotov cocktail or other firebomb.

§ 132.12 POSSESSION OF MATERIALS RESTRICTED.

It shall be unlawful for any person or group of persons to possess all the items or materials needed to manufacture molotov cocktails or other firebombs, other than on his or their premises.
