## RESOLUTION R-10-05

### RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN NAMING DARLENE WHISENANT AS TOWN CLERK FOR THE TOWN OF BLACK MOUNTAIN

**WHEREAS**, North Carolina General Statute §160A-171 requires that local governments designate a position to serve as Town Clerk, who shall give notice of meetings of the council, keep a journal of the proceedings of the council, be the custodian of all city records, and shall perform any other duties that may be required by law or the council; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Manager has the responsibility and the authority under the Town Charter, subject to provisions of the Council-Manager Plan of Government, to appoint all city officers and employees not elected by the people, including the town clerk; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Manager commends Darlene Whisenant to fulfill the duties of Town Clerk, and wishes her to assume these duties effective March 1, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Black Mountain Board of Aldermen has already unanimously endorsed the appointment of Darlene Whisenant to the role of Town Clerk during its annual planning retreat on February 18, 2010;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Black Mountain that it recognizes and endorses the manager's appointment of Darlene Whisenant to the position of Town Clerk, and acknowledges her service as clerk to the board with responsibilities, specified by NC General Statute and by the Charter of the Town of Black Mountain.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Darlene Whisenant is hereby duly recognized under State Law as having the authority, duties and power as exercised by the Town Clerk for the Town of Black Mountain.
