



LIBERTY TREE MEMORIAL AGREEMENT

1. We understand that the Liberty Tree Society (LTS) wants the Town of Black Mountain, NC to be a Liberty Tree Memorial site.

The Memorial package consists of :

- a. American Liberty Elm Tree, minimum of 14 feet tall, (freight prepaid) ready for immediate planting.
 - b. Commemorative Bronze Tablet, 21" x 12" x 1/2", recounting the dramatic events which made the Liberty Tree America's first symbol of freedom.
 - c. Framed print of American Elm Etching with Thomas Paine's poem called "Liberty Tree" to be hung in town hall.
 - d. Framed certificate of membership in the Liberty Tree Society and a copy of the Proclamation by the Governor of Massachusetts establishing August 14th as Liberty Tree Day to be hung in town hall.
 - e. (200) copies of the Liberty Tree Society brochures.
 - f. (2) copies of "Whatever Happened to America's Liberty Tree?" book and Teacher's Guide, a classroom project for elementary and middle school students.
2. We agree to accept this gift and establish this Memorial commemorating the birth of freedom in our country with a suitable ceremony and celebration. We will establish the Liberty Tree in a prominent location and will mount the Liberty Tree plaque on a permanent base near the tree. We understand that, in order to make this gift possible, Elm Research Institute relies on the generosity of its Liberty Tree Society members nationwide.
