RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN IN SUPPORT OF BUNCOMBE COUNTY'S GRANT APPLICATION TO THE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION FOR FUNDING TO UPDATE THE COUNTYWIDE MASTER GREENWAY PLAN

WHEREAS, Buncombe County's existing Greenway Plan is designed to coordinate current and future greenway development with the other municipalities within its jurisdiction and neighboring counties; and

WHEREAS, Buncombe County through the Buncombe County's Parks, Greenways and Recreation Services Department and its Trails and Greenways Commission works with other municipalities through staff and the commission to implement the existing Greenway Plan; and

WHEREAS, currently there is grant funding available to update and enhance the existing Greenway Plan on a regional basis; and

WHEREAS, the updated Plan will provide all jurisdictions within Buncombe County with working documents which will assist in the prioritization and implementation of a regional greenway plan; and

WHEREAS, a regional greenway plan will better assist all jurisdictions for state and federal funding opportunities; and

WHEREAS, a regional approach to greenway planning will provide a benefit for residents of Black Mountain, NC;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Black Mountain that the Town of Black Mountain does hereby support Buncombe County's application to the Metropolitan Planning Organization for funding to conduct an update of the countywide Master Greenway Plan.
