

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN
ADOPTING A STATEMENT OF CONSISTENCY WITH
THE 2004 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AS REGARDS**

**AMENDING THE FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION ORDINANCE AND
ADOPTING 2010 FLOOD INSURANCE RATE MAPS**

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen desires to improve and protect the safety and welfare of people and property located within the designated Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA); and

WHEREAS, the Town must adopt the updated Flood Insurance Rate Map and regulations in order to maintain the jurisdiction's eligibility to participate in the National Flood Insurance Program; and

WHEREAS, the 2004 Comprehensive Plan calls for protection of environmental health and safety, stream protection, and flood and stormwater management;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in accordance with the provisions of the North Carolina General Statute 160A-383, the Board of Aldermen hereby finds and determines that the adoption of updates to the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance, Chapter 151 of the Town Code of Ordinances, and the revised Flood Insurance Rate Maps, are consistent with the adopted 2004 Comprehensive Plan and Section 153.151 "Requirement for Change" of the Town Code of Ordinances, and find these changes are both reasonable and in the public interest.
