

**GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE  
NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION  
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM  
US 70 SIDEWALK– TIP PROJECT #U-5178  
AGREEMENT ID # 571**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Governing Board of the Town of Black Mountain, North Carolina, that, pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following grant project ordinance is hereby adopted:

**Section 1.** The project authorized is for the installation of a sidewalk on the north side of US Hwy 70 from Blue Ridge Road (SR 2500) to Grovestone Road (SR 2472) and Blue Ridge Road (SR 2500).

**Section 2.** The length of the project is 120 days beginning 12-31-2009.

**Section 3.** This project will be financed with federal funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) and all ARRA funding requirements will be required.

**Section 4.** The officers of this unit are hereby directed to proceed with the grant project within the terms of the grant agreement documents, and the budget contained herein.

**Section 5.** The following amounts are appropriated for the project:

Construction	<u>219,000</u>

**Section 6.** The following revenues are anticipated to be available to complete this project:

NC DOT/ARRA Grant Funds	\$ 264,000
Local Match	<u>0</u>

**Section 7.** The Finance Officer is hereby directed to maintain within the Grant Project Funds sufficient specific detailed accounting records to satisfy the requirements of the grantor agency and the grant agreements. The term of the agreement also shall be met.

**Section 8.** Funds may be advanced from the General Fund for the purpose of making payments as due. Reimbursement requests should be made to the financing agency and North Carolina Department of Transportation in an orderly and timely manner as outlined in the Agreement ID #571.

**Section 9.** The Finance Officer is directed to report, on a quarterly basis, on the financial status of each project element in Section 4 and on the total grant revenues received or claimed.

**Section 10.** The Budget Officer is directed to include a detailed analysis of past and future costs and revenues on this grant project in every budget submission made to this Board.

**Section 11.** Copies of this grant project ordinance shall be furnished to the Clerk to the Governing Board, and to the Budget Officer and Finance Officer for direction in carrying out this project.
